


History The Ancient Maya

They will learn how this extraordinary civilisation created beautiful writing using logograms and hieroglyph; discover the fascinating inventive maths and calendar systems; study the impressive buildings of this very early civilisation; and learn about the society of the Maya community



Key Learning:-

- Develop a chronologically secure knowledge and understanding of world history, establishing clear narratives within and across the periods they study.
- Understand how our knowledge of the past is constructed from a range of sources.
- Undertake an in-depth study of a non-European society that provides contrasts with British history- The Maya civilization.

As Artists, we shall recognise different functions of artwork and the purpose of art in the wider world. Look at and talk about drawings from other periods and cultures
As Geographers we will name and locate countries in South America
